You'd think that it wouldn't take much coaxing to get your kids to want to spend time away from home. Well, sometimes it takes a little nudge.

HERE ARE SOME IDEAS TO HELP THEM ALONG.

1. Show video clips from past years and have campers from those years talk about it.
2. Have a "CAMP DAY" after church on Sunday. Invite parents and kids and show video clips from the past year.
3. Send out fliers weekly for six weeks.
4. Advertise in the church newsletter.
5. Have a contest between boys and girls to see who can sign up the most friends for camp.
6. Put up a display board with photos from last year and a video monitor in the lobby of your church.
7. Have a Forest Home night where you show a video from camp and have a drawing for Chocolate Chip Shake Certificates and give away Bookstore cash.
8. Put up posters and hand out fliers to any kid you see on Sunday morning.
9. Do skits on Sunday morning.
10. Invite youth who have been to camp before to share about some of their most memorable moments from those times.
11. Offer price incentives.
12. Create a promo video with music and special effects and show it on Sundays.
13. Set up a registration table at church with signs, t-shirts, & hats.
14. Have kids who have gone to camp give a testimony to other kids.
15. Encourage them to bring their non-church friends.
16. Set up a photo board from the last camp.
17. Give parents and grandparents the opportunity to give camp as a Christmas present.
18. Display the "official" camp photo in the lobby. Tell kids that they don't want to be left out this year.
19. Show the Indian Village and Adventure Mountain video.
20. Create a list of who's going to camp.

21. "RENT-A-KID". Encourage kids to offer their services to church members in the way of yard work or house work.
22. Put up a Church Chore sheet and have kids sign up to do work around the church. Call it "Camp Cash".
23. Hold a pancake breakfast. People can't resist food!
24. Have a yard sale. Okay, it's not the most original idea, but it can earn lots of moo-la.
25. Have a "Spaghetti Feed" and have the kids work for tips.
26. Hold a "Bible Jeopardy" game show with teams competing for "Camp Cash".
27. Hold an auction with items donated by church members.
28. Take a special offering at church.
29. Set up payments plans.
30. Start a tree recycling program.
31. Ask certain families in church to sponsor a kid for camp.
32. Offer to discount a kid's fees if their parent drives kids to camp or drives a bus.
33. Have a major, all-church concert. Have students sell cookies and drinks during the event.
34. Conduct a Jog-A-Thon.
35. Offer scholarships by learning scripture passages.
36. Have a Church Barn sale.
37. Approach a secular Board and ask for assistance. Bring a youth along to give a testimony of what Forest Home has done in their life.
38. Take a Saturday and turn the church parking lot into a car wash.
39. Give away \$5 discounts for memorizing verses in Sunday School.
40. Hold a "50/50" raffle.
41. Have youth sell "Fundraiser" food coupon books.
42. Hold a "Taco Feed" after church.
43. Give scholarships for babysitting at all-church functions.
44. Enlist youth to create a yard service and approach church members.
